A) Coached Youth Groups (dates and times displayed on the noticeboard)

Coached groups run throughout the summer on the beach and during the winter in the pool. Groups are subject to strict number restrictions for safety reasons and we maintain a ratio of supervisors to participants in line with SLSGB recommendations. Participants must be able to confidently swim the following as a minimum in a pool before attending ANY training sessions. The following standards are also expected prior to using any club equipment:

B) Adult Groups (dates and times displayed on the noticeboard)

The club also runs a variety of groups for adults including: slippery eels (sea swimming), surf boat (ladies & mens teams), open (club) evenings, pool sessions, yoga, beach lifeguard, first aid and coaching awards. Keep an eye on the noticeboard / website / facebook for details & times.

C) Insurance

Full membership of the club conveys limited personal accident and public liability insurance for both surfing and surf-lifesaving **during organized club activities**. More information can be found on the **SLSGB** and **Surfing England** websites. Full membership of the club also conveys limited public liability insurance for use of equipment outside of club sessions so long as it is being used within the club guidelines. **It is up to you to ensure that these products meet your needs.**

D) Equipment and premises use

Full members wishing to use the club equipment outside of official events/training should only do so **under the supervision of a qualified lifeguard** and this is actively enforced for full members under 16. In addition, 'Nipper' age full members must have **dedicated adult supervision**, in addition to any lifeguards, to use any of our equipment (a parent 'somewhere on the beach' does not count!). The use of hard boards (eg Rescue Board / SUP) is limited to those with a relevant qualification / experience.

Any members using the premises should familiarize themselves with the location and operation of fire extinguishers, first aid kits, emergency exits and the locations of the nearest available telephones.

E) Use of personal information

Names (only) of all club full members are displayed on the surf club notice-board. For affiliation to the SLSGB / Surfing England your details will be forwarded to the relevant organization.

Relevant medical information and emergency contact numbers disclosed on the membership form will appear on training session registers but will not be generally disclosed.

F) Comments and suggestions - Committee meetings

A committee meeting is held monthly. All members are welcome to attend, but only elected committee members may take part in any vote. If you've got anything you'd like raised at a meeting or would like to attend please let the chairperson / secretary know.

G) Contests and training

The club aims to provide financial assistance for those representing the club professionally/competitively or in attaining relevant qualifications that can (and will) be used to benefit other members of the club.

H) Payment

Membership runs from **November-November** and payment can be made by cheque (payable to St Agnes SLSC), cash, secure online card payments or bank transfer.
