#### **CORRESPONDANCE AND MATTERS ARISING**

1. (Joel H) Update on 1st September safeguarding incident.

A positive update from Steve H (CSO) regarding safeguarding incident on 1<sup>st</sup> September. The offending party has attended diversity awareness training, and now both parties involved are now attending coached sessions again.

The committee commend Steve H (CSO) and Paul M (L2 Coach) for positive solution around a difficult circumstance.

2. (Joel H) Report of surfer aggression including racist abuse on 23rd October.

An incident on the beach of racially motivated aggression was managed in the moment by a club member. The committee understood and agreed that any further action from the club falls outside of the club's safeguarding policy, and that of SLSGB. However whilst the club cannot intervene, the committee recommends that the incident be fully reported to police.
